Garden 5: Welcome to MillHaven Farm!



We use the no dig method or sometimes referred to as "No Till". It's all about trying to keep something growing all the time or the soil covered with mulch and as little soil disturbance as possible!

"We ask please not to step on the beds and to stick to the paths"

Things to see and do during your visit:

- Catch our talk at quarter past every hour, at the tool shed (listen for the bell and coo-ee)
- Working Compost Tea demo at the tool shed
- JADAM Organic demo (weather dependant). This is new to us so would love to find others who are using it to! JADAM refers to an organic farming group aimed at farming in harmony with nature.

Check out the noticeboard in the tool shed for info on vegetable bed planting:

- There are 7 beds areas
- Each has 5 or 6 rows
- Plus there are some raised beds
- Along with our garlic growing area for selling at the Farmers Market

Wondering what's in the old compost bin system?

- Bay 1 cow manure compost
- Bay 2 New home-made compost
- Bay 3 Mature home -made compost
- Bay 4 Starting new compost pile
- Bay 5 Horse manure compost trial

Plus there's more to see:

- You're welcome to check out the bee hive (it's a little different from the norm!). But please don't pass the line, we don't want to upset them!
- Take a walk to the wetland rehabilitation area. See depth marker for how much water table moves each year. You will be surprised!
