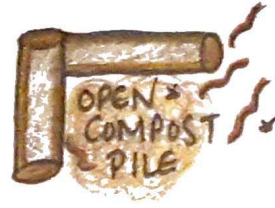

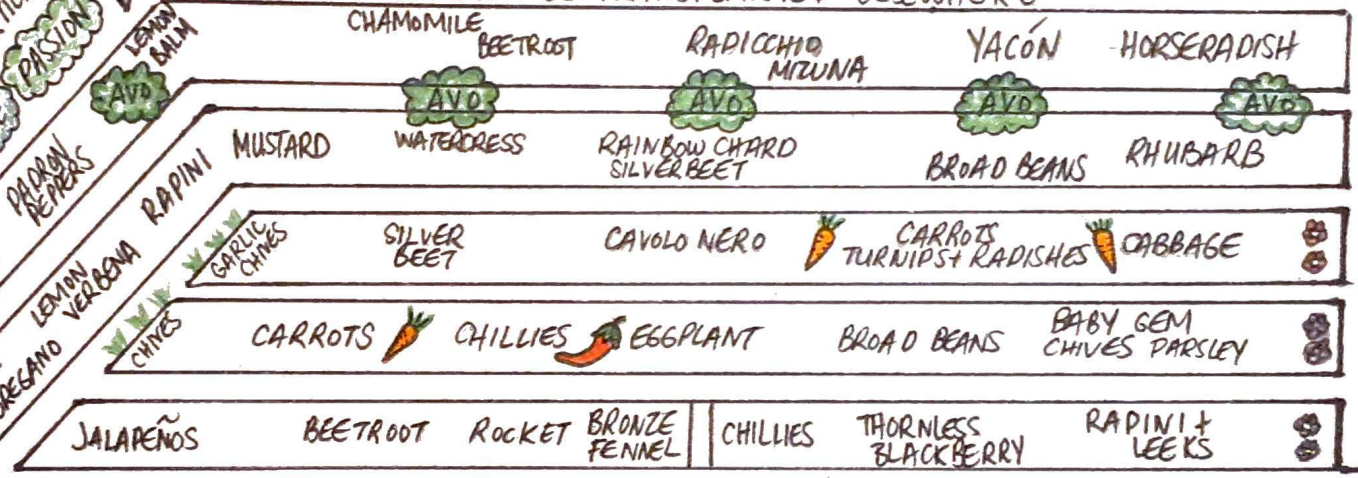

OUR GREENHOUSE WAS BUILT IN SPRING '23. IT HAS ALLOWED US TO EXTEND OUR GROWING SEASON AND HAVE PLENTY OF STRONG SEEDLINGS TO PLANT OUT WHEN THE TIME IS RIGHT. WE SOW + TRANSPLANT REGULARLY.

THERE IS A FAN RUNNING FOR GOOD AIRFLOW AND OVERHEAD MISTERS ON A TIMER SO SEEDLINGS ARE ALWAYS MOIST.

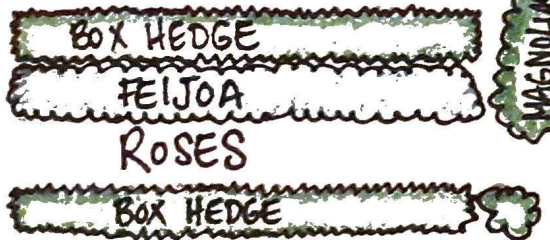
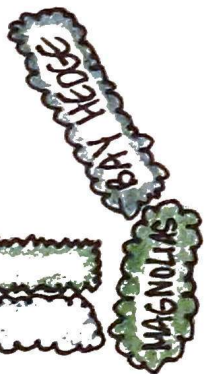
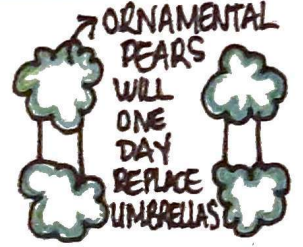

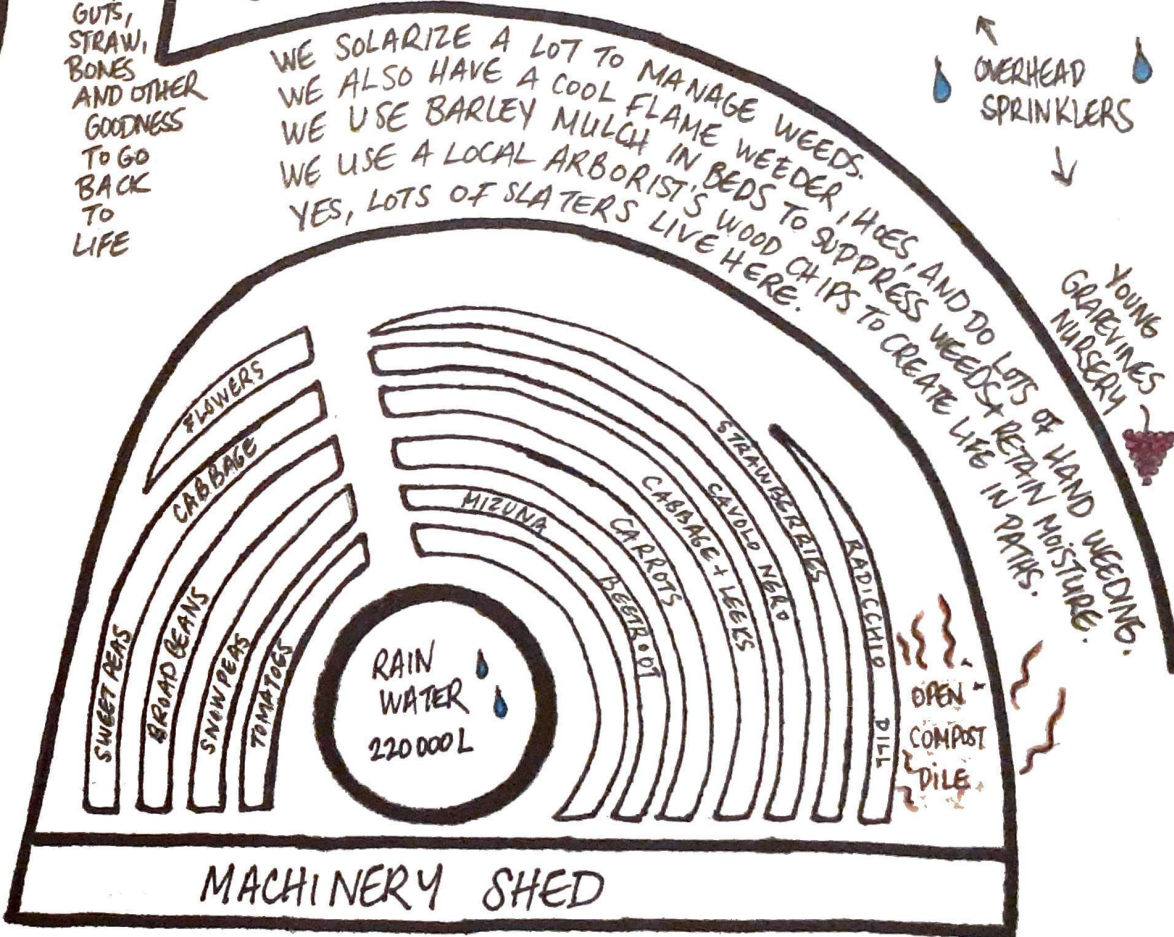
NEW BEDS. WE GREW CORN AND LOTS OF WEEDS.
